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Free training to create young engaged Europeans

YouthMetre launches new training materials to empower young Europeans.

On November 1st 2017, YouthMetre launched its new online training resources for young European citizens. In five modules, the training invites young people from all of Europe to become powerful policy advocates and create their own successful political campaigns.

The training is carefully tailored to organisations and institutions working with youth looking to help empower and involve young Europeans in their region's policy making.

Used online and for free, the modules take you by the hand all the way from understanding the European Youth Policy to creating a political elevator pitch.

“Learning is doing, so all our online modules have exercises that can be done together with the participants. Most of them using our interactive community maps and apps”, says Caterina Impastato from YouthMetre's Italian partner organisation CESIE.

Funded by the European Commission's Erasmus+ Program, YouthMetre aims to create structured dialogue between EU's authorities and the union's young inhabitants.
